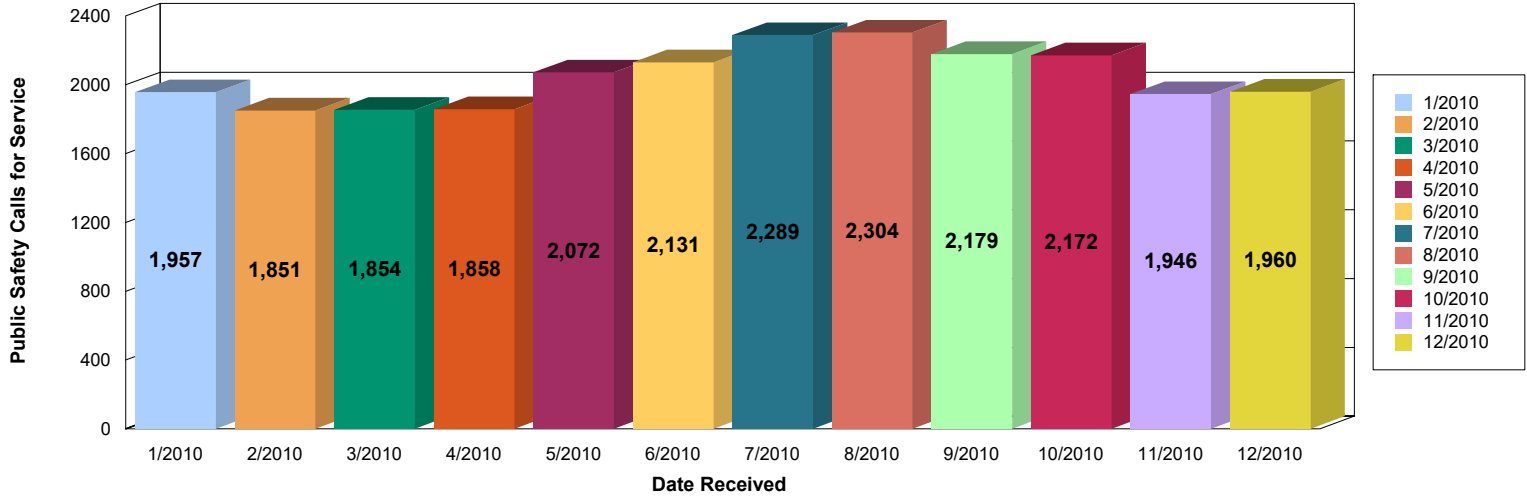

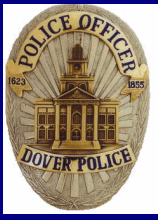

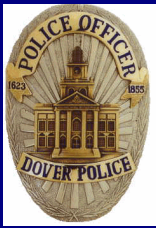

2. **PRIORITY TWO:** Calls for service within this assignment category require RAPID RESPONSE. Priority two calls include:
 - a. Crimes or incidents that are not in-progress, but which require RAPID police response to investigate criminal activity in order to preserve evidence, locate witnesses or provide for public safety.
 - b. This category also includes order maintenance and disturbance calls which indicate a potential for property damage.
Ex: Susp Act IP, Assault NIP, Dist-Domestic, Viol Restrtn Ord, Harassment IP, Burglary NIP...
3. **PRIORITY THREE:** Calls for service within this assignment category require a TIMELY RESPONSE. Priority three calls include:
 - a. Order maintenance, disturbance and noise violations where there is no known potential for damage or injury.
Ex: Check-up, Dist-NV, Dist-MV, Welfare Chk 911, Accident, Protective Cust, Road Hazzard, Dist-Party...
4. **PRIORITY FOUR:** Calls for service within this category are defined as calls that require that police response be made AS OFFICERS BECOME AVAILABLE. Priority Four calls include:
 - a. Calls for service for non-criminal related activity, as well as crimes reported well after they have been committed where a police response is requested.
Ex: Deliver Message, Tow, Littering, Fingerprint, Assistance, Police Info, Theft NIP, Vin Check, Abandoned MV, Animal...

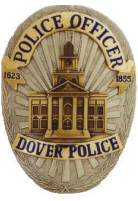

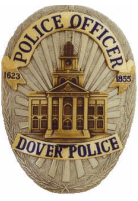

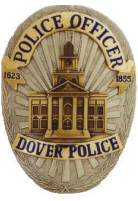
