



Policy on Wireless Internet Access

Free wireless Internet access is available at the Dover Public Library. You don't need a plug or phone jack, just turn on your notebook/laptop computer or other wireless device and start surfing.

Requirements

You will need a notebook/laptop computer or other wireless device with 802.11a, 802.11b or 802.11g wireless networking.

If you are not sure if your notebook/laptop computer or other device has this functionality, please check with the manufacturer or supplier of your equipment. If your notebook/laptop computer or other device does not include wireless networking, you may be able to purchase a variety of external notebook/laptop pc cards and USB devices. The manufacturer or supplier of your equipment, or local technology merchants can help you

We have tried to make wireless access as available as possible in the library, but you may encounter some "dead" spots where wireless reception may be limited. If you have trouble accessing the Internet or staying online, please move closer to the library's Reference Room.
