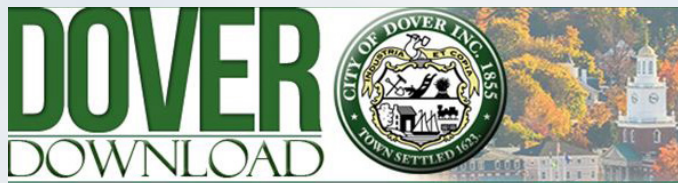

## CITY CHARTER AND CITY CODE

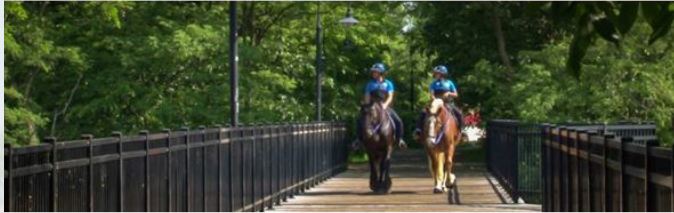

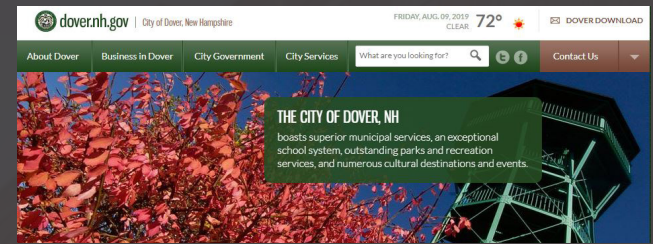

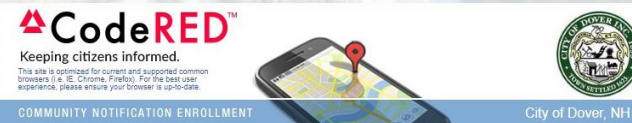
