- Roadway and Pavement Restoration




### **Temporary Potable Water System**


- Minimize Impacts to Businesses & Residents
- Some Temporary Shutdowns Cannot be Avoided (Valve Installation; Temp Water Connections; Permanent Water Connections)
- Isolation Gate Valves Installed at Night
- Advance Notices for Water Shutdowns will be Provided

























- Anticipate Work Zones to Change Daily

#### **Pavement Restoration**

- No Open Trenches Left Overnight
- Property Accessibility Maintained
- Temporary Impacts Anticipated
- Pavement, Sidewalk, Driveway
  Restorations will Follow Water
  Main Installation and Testing
- Pavement Mill & Overlay of
  Entire Roadway Upon Completion





### **Anticipated Schedule**

- Start Construction
  - Install Isolation Valves (Night Work)
  - Install Temporary Water System
  - Install Water Main & Services
  - Trench Pavement Restoration
- Pavement Overlay
- Project Closeout
