## Please adhere to these rules of courtesy:


- Trail is a City of Dover linear park and all City Park rules apply.

- All dogs must be leashed at all times.
- All dog owners are required to pick up dog waste and dispose of properly.
- No motorized vehicles except for wheelchairs.
- No fishing from bridge.
- Bicyclists please yield to pedestrians.
- No possession or use of alcoholic beverages
- No fireworks or fires.
- No camping.
- Please respect adjoining landowners and stay within trail boundaries.

- Section between Dover Transportation Center and Washington Street is open during train and bus service.

- Remaining sections of the trail are open:  
 April 1 - September 30 7:00 a.m - 9:30 p.m.  
 October 1 - March 31 7:00 a.m - 7:00 p.m.
