Chief Anthony Colarusso of the Dover Police Department announces the arrest of John Fenton, 66 years old, of 56 Durham Road #53, Dover, NH, on a charge of Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault, a felony.

The Dover Police Department began an investigation after receiving a report on September 7, 2016 that Fenton had sexually assaulted the victim at Fenton's residence between June 2015 and August 2016. As a result of the investigation, DPD detectives obtained an arrest warrant charging Fenton with engaging in a pattern of sexual assaults against the victim, a then twelve year old male who was known to Fenton.

Fenton turned himself into police on September 26, 2016 without incident.

Fenton was released on \$45,000.00 personal recognizance bail. He is scheduled to be arraigned in the Strafford County Superior Court at 9:00 AM on December 2, 2016.
