## DOVER POLICE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES ARREST IN BURGLARY INVESTIGATION

**DOVER, NH**, August 6, 2019 - Chief William Breault of the Dover Police Department announces that the Dover Police Department has made an arrest in the burglary that occurred during the early morning hours of August 1, 2019, at Temescal Wellness, a medical marijuana dispensary located on Crosby Road in Dover.

Dover Police Department officers responded to the scene within minutes after receiving notification from the business's alarm monitoring company just after midnight. The responding officers, including members of the DPD's Crime Scene Unit, determined that suspect(s) had broken a glass door with a rock and accessed the customer service area of the dispensary.

The investigation determined that the suspects stole some items on display for sale, but were unable to access the marijuana storage area, which has several additional layers of security.

The DPD's Special Investigations Unit was able to identify the three suspects, two of whom are juveniles, and obtained an arrest warrant for one adult. On August 5, 2019 at approximately 7:00 PM, DPD patrol officers arrested Travis Garand, 21, on that warrant. Garand was arrested without incident on Adelle Drive. He was released on personal recognizance bail and is scheduled to be arraigned in Strafford County Superior Court on August 15, 2019.

As previously reported, two male juveniles face charges in this case as well, but, due to their juvenile status, no further information will be publically released.
