## **DOVER POLICE ARREST 7 IN GRANITE SHIELD SWEEP**

**DOVER, NH**, June 11, 2020 - Chief William Breault announces the arrest of several local individuals for drug related offenses. On the evening of June 10, 2020, investigators from the Dover Police Department engaged in targeted enforcement of the state's drugs laws and arrested:

- Michael Harper, 33, 24 Redden Street, Dover, NH for Possession of a Controlled Drug (heroin) with Intent to Distribute, a felony offense.
- Tiffany Chase, 28, homeless, for Possession of a Controlled Drug (methamphetamine) with Intent to Distribute, a felony offense.
- Brent Taylor, 53, 125 Sagamore Avenue, Portsmouth, NH for Possession of a Controlled Drug (heroin), a felony offense
- Kelsey Savage, 49, 120 Durham Road, Dover, NH for Possession of a Controlled Drug (heroin), a felony offense.

Both Harper and Chase were held at the Strafford County Jail.

Taylor and Savage were released on personal recognizance and are scheduled to appear in the Strafford County Superior Court on July 6, 2020.

Dover Police also made three arrests of local individuals with active arrest warrants:

- Chrystal Derenzo, 38, 3 Bennett Way #106, Newmarket, NH for Theft and Fraudulent Use of a Credit Card, both misdemeanor offenses.
- Stephen White, 51, 73 Newmarket Road, Durham, NH, for Conduct After An Accident, a misdemeanor offense.
- Katherine Radie, 28, 89 Pleasant View Circle, Dover, NH, for Disorderly Conduct, a misdemeanor offense.
