**DOVER, NH**, August 4, 2020 - Chief William Breault announces the arrest of four local individuals during a drug investigation. On the evening of August 1, 2020, investigators from the Dover Police Department engaged in targeted enforcement of the state's drugs laws in the Elliot Park neighborhood after receiving multiple complaints from members of the community about drug sales and ongoing quality of life issues in the area. As a result of the investigation, the Dover Police Department arrested:

Jamie Lanciano, age 34, 23 ½ New York Street, Dover, for Possession of a Controlled Drug (methamphetamine), a felony offense.

Brianna Shaw, age 24, 179 Franklin Street, Rochester, for Possession of a Controlled Drug (Suboxone), a felony offense.

Christopher Morin, age 35, 6 Elliot Park, Dover, for an outstanding warrant issued from the Strafford County Superior Court.

Paul Hayes, age 61, 6 Elliot Park, Dover, for Possession of a Controlled Drug (methamphetamine), and Felon in Possession of a Firearm, both felony offenses.

During this investigation, Dover Police executed two search warrants, impounded a vehicle, seized \$1,800 in cash, \$240 in counterfeit money, recovered methamphetamine, fentanyl, drug paraphernalia, and a stolen pistol.

Lanciano, Shaw, and Hayes were released on personal recognizance and are scheduled to appear in the Strafford County Superior Court on a date to be determined by the court. Morin was held without bail and released to the custody of the Strafford County Jail.

This incident remains under investigation. It is possible that more individuals will be charged or that those already arrested will face additional charges.
