## FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE DOVER POLICE SEEK ASSISTANCE IN LOCATING INVOLVED DRIVER

**DOVER, NH:** On August 17, 2020, at approximately 6:28 PM, Dover Police and Dover Fire & Rescue responded to Indian Brook Drive near the Route 16 southbound on ramp for the report of a hit and run collision involving a motorcycle.

An initial investigation determined a 24-year-old Dover resident driving a 2007 Harley-Davidson motorcycle had been travelling westbound on Indian Brook Drive when what was described as either a silver or gray pickup truck, possibly a Dodge or Chevrolet, made a U-turn in front of him. The motorcycle collided with the passenger side of the truck, causing the rider to fall to the ground and the motorcycle to continue westbound against a guardrail for approximately one hundred yards. The driver of the motorcycle was transported to the Portsmouth Regional Hospital with serious, but non-life threatening injuries.

The pickup truck fled the scene. Officers are looking to identify this vehicle and its driver. It is believed this truck might have red or burgundy paint transfer on the on the passenger side.
