1. **PRIORITY ONE:** Calls for service within this assignment category require IMMEDIATE RESPONSE. Priority one calls include:

 - b. Incidents where the IMMEDIATE response of police is necessary to protect citizens in life-threatening situations, or where the risk exists of serious injury to individuals or the public at large.
Ex: Theft IP, Dist-V, Crim Misch-IP, Accid-Injury, Hit & Run IP, Med Aid, Panic Alarm, Robbery IP, Burglary IP...
2. **PRIORITY TWO:** Calls for service within this assignment category require RAPID RESPONSE. Priority two calls include:

3. **PRIORITY THREE:** Calls for service within this assignment category require a TIMELY RESPONSE. Priority three calls include:
 - a. Order maintenance, disturbance and noise violations where there is no known potential for damage or injury.
Ex: Check-up, Dist-NV, Dist-MV, Welfare Chk 911, Accident, Protective Cust, Road Hazzard, Dist-Party...
4. **PRIORITY FOUR:** Calls for service within this category are defined as calls that require that police response be made AS OFFICERS BECOME AVAILABLE. Priority Four calls include:
 - a. Calls for service for non-criminal related activity, as well as crimes reported well after they have been committed where a police response is requested.
Ex: Deliver Message, Tow, Littering, Fingerprint, Assistance, Police Info, Theft NIP, Vin Check, Abandoned MV, Animal...

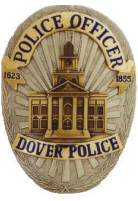

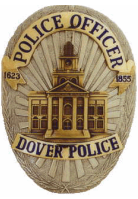

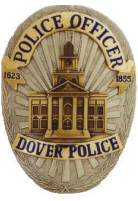
