



Dover Public Library Mobile Hotspot Lending Policy

The Dover Public Library offers Mobile Hotspots in its Library of Things collection.

- You must be 18 years or older and sign the LOT waiver in order to borrow. Only permanent borrower cards are eligible to borrow Mobile Hotspots. As with any item borrowed from the library, the Mobile Hotspot is required to be returned in good condition within the allotted loan period.
- Mobile Hotspots circulate for 2 weeks and may not be renewed. Mobile Hotspots may be borrowed only once a month, which applies to anyone in the same household, to allow other patrons access to the devices.
- While the library does not charge overdue fees, overdue Mobile Hotspots will be noted on the patron record and after the 2nd time it is returned overdue, the patron and anyone in the same household, will lose the right to borrow Mobile Hotspots for 3 months. Overdue Mobile Hotspots may be deactivated as soon as one day past due. The library reserves the right to refuse Mobile Hotspot service to those who abuse checked out materials or equipment or are repeatedly late in returning borrowed items.
- Devices may only be used in the continental United States. Any charges accrued as the result of misuse will be the responsibility of the patron.
- Tampering with Library equipment, including bypassing security functions, is prohibited.

Proper Care and Use of the Mobile Hotspot

- As with any electronic device, do not leave the Mobile Hotspot in a hot vehicle for an extended period.
- Do not remove the SIM card for any reason.
- All cords and other materials must be present in the Mobile Hotspot case for it to be considered returned.
- When returning a Mobile Hotspot, please do not use the book drop; return the Mobile Hotspot in-person to a library staff member at the circulation desk.

Replacement Cost:

- Replacement cost for the Mobile Hotspot and accompanying cables is \$117.00.
