
6:00-7:30 pm (Family Event) We will have food, games, and music to celebrate the end of our summer reading program.

How the Program Works

Preschool If you haven't already, sign-up for the 1000 Books Before Kindergarten program. After reading the first 100 books, receive a canvas tote bag. When you complete the challenge, choose a gift book and get your picture on the Wall of Fame. Also, pick up a summer activity sheet and turn it in for a prize when it is complete.

Entering Kindergarten - Grade 6

When you sign-up for the summer reading program, choose which team you would like to be on; Patriots, Celtics, Bruins, or Red Sox. You will receive a calendar to record the number of minutes you read, or are read to, everyday. When you come to the library, bring your calendar with the minutes added up. For every hour you read, you will receive a team token. If the token has a dot on the back, you get a prize. Which team will read the most?

Weekly Raffle Every time you come to the library, fill out a raffle ticket. Each Friday at 4:00 pm we will choose a winner who will receive a special prize.
