At Home Creation Station Jellyfish Salt and Glue Painting



Materials needed:

card stock, heavy construction paper, or cardboard paint brush liquid food coloring and water or liquid watercolor paints salt liquid glue (not glue stick)

Directions:

- 1. First you'll squeeze your glue designs onto your card stock paper. You can make a jellyfish or design some other shape that would be easy for you to make with glue. Use your imagination!
- 2. Sprinkle your design with salt until it is covered and then shake off the excess salt.
- 3. If you don't have liquid watercolor paints for this next step, you can use food coloring instead. Fill some disposable plastic cups halfway full with water and place a few drops of food coloring into each cup. You'll then dip your paintbrush into the paint and gently touch the salt covered glue lines and magically watch the paint travel and mix colors. If you'd like, a medicine dropper would work well for this activity too. Once you're finished painting you can set it aside to dry for a day or two.









4. Once dry, display your salt and glue painting! Have fun!
