

## At Home Creation Station - SRP 2020 - Week 2

### Cupcake Liner Dragon



#### **SUPPLIES NEEDED:**

- cardstock or construction paper
- mini cupcake liners
- googly eyes
- gold and white paper
- red yarn (or another color)
- orange and yellow tissue paper (or construction paper)
- scissors and glue

#### **CUPCAKE LINER DRAGON CRAFT INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Begin by cutting about eight mini cupcake liners in half. Glue one of the cupcake liner halves onto your paper, towards the top. This is the start of your dragon's body. Continue gluing and layering the cupcake liner halves down your page to form your dragon's body. Now make your dragon's head. You'll need two cupcake liners. Cut one of them in half and fold the other liner in half. Cut the sides off of both of these pieces. Glue the two pieces together to make a dragon head, making sure the folded section opens and closes at the bottom of the face. Or, design your own dragon head!
2. Glue your dragon's head onto the beginning of your dragon's body. Cut horns from your gold paper and glue them onto your dragon. Cut out white teeth and glue them on the inside of the dragon's mouth. Cut out a few small pieces of orange and yellow tissue paper (or construction paper) and glue them on the inside of your dragon's mouth. Crinkle the ends of the tissue a little to look like fire coming out of the dragon's mouth.
3. Finish your cupcake liner dragon craft by drawing nostrils on your dragon with a red marker and then glue two short strands of red (or any color) yarn to the dragon's face like long whiskers. Have fun!
