WHEREAS: September 17, 2023, marks the 236th anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention in 1787; and

- WHEREAS: The Constitution is our Nation's guiding document and it is important to recognize and celebrate its existence, while recalling the strength and bravery of those who fought for The Constitution and its amendments throughout history; and
- WHEREAS: The Constitution officially became the law of the United States on June 21, 1788, when New Hampshire became the ninth state to ratify the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS: Each year September 17-23 is designated as Constitution Week by the President of the United States, and it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this memorable document and the patriotic celebrations that will commemorate it; and
- WHEREAS: Constitution Week is a great opportunity for citizens to learn about, understand, and defend the Constitution.

NOW, THEREFORE I, Robert Carrier, Mayor of the City of Dover in the State of New Hampshire, do hereby proclaim the week of September 17 through 23 as
