- WHEREAS:** The Saints hosted the quarterfinal round where they triumphed over #5 Mascoma in a thrilling 3–2 overtime victory, avenging Mascoma’s regular-season win over St. Thomas; and
- WHEREAS:** Advancing to the Semifinals, the Saints displayed perseverance and skill in a hard-fought 2–1 victory against #1 Berlin High School; and
- WHEREAS:** In the Championship Game, St. Thomas Aquinas faced the #2 seed Mascenic Vikings—who had edged out the Saints 1–0 in the regular season—and secured a resounding 4–0 victory to claim the 2025 NHIAA Division III Field Hockey State Championship; and
- WHEREAS:** This Championship marks the second Field Hockey State Title in school history, the first having been earned in 2003;
