

## **PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS: The loss of an infant, unborn or stillborn is devastating, and too many families

grieve in silence, sometimes never coming to terms with their significant loss;

and

WHEREAS: October 15th is Pregnancy and Infant Loss Remembrance Day, which seeks to

promote greater awareness and support for the families whose lives are irrevocably altered by the death of their child during pregnancy, at birth, or in

infancy; and

WHEREAS: Jasper Lake Lamontagne was stillborn on August 25, 2018.

WHEREAS: Jasper's mother, Aubrey Lamontagne, took the tragedy of the death of her baby

to found the non-profit organization Jasper's Heart that supports those like herself who have experienced the loss of an unborn, stillborn, and/or infant and create the Children's Memory Garden at Pine Hill Cemetery, a place where

families will be able to memorialize and celebrate their child.
