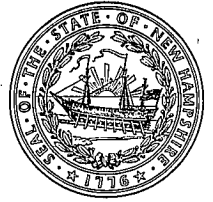

Congratulations on your successful application to the 2008 Restoration for Impaired Waters Grants program! The Department of Environmental Services awards a \$68,064 Restoration Grant to the City of Dover to complete the *Willand Pond Drainage Establishment and Outreach Program* Project, pending Governor and Executive Council approval.

To award the funds, we must enter into a grant agreement. Your Full Proposal will be used as a basis for the agreement language. We will forward a draft grant agreement to you in the next week or so. Your DES project leader will contact you to schedule a meeting to discuss the proposed agreement, and the general State grant agreement requirements and procedures. Following that meeting, and once DES and your organization have agreed upon an acceptable grant agreement, you will be asked to submit signed and notarized agreement documents. Those documents will then be submitted to the Governor and Executive Council for consideration of their approval.
