The Dover Police Department is seeking the public's assistance with identifying a suspect involved in a credit card fraud and motor vehicle theft.

On August 30, 2016, a Maine resident reported that her vehicle was stolen from the parking lot of Planet Fitness in Dover. Shortly thereafter, the victim discovered that her credit cards, which were in the car at the time of the theft, were used at several businesses in Plaistow, NH. DPD detectives obtained security footage from Walmart and TJ Maxx in Plaistow that contained images of an unidentified female using the cards.

The victim's vehicle was spotted on September 20, 2016, in Exeter, NH, by an Exeter police officer. The operator of the vehicle at that time, Michael Page, 33, of 2 Wendover Lane in Raymond, NH, was arrested by Exeter Police for Receiving Stolen Property, a Felony offense.

The Dover Police Department is seeking the public's assistance with identifying the female in the security video.
