The Dover Police Department announces the arrest of Aaron Tilton, age 24, of Middle Road in Dover, NH, for the crime of Driving While Intoxicated, Subsequent Offense, a Class A misdemeanor.

On February 27, 2017, at approximately 11:51 p.m., Dover Police and Dover Fire & Rescue responded to the area of Back Road near the intersection with Henry Law Ave for the report of a single vehicle collision.

Officers subsequently determined that Tilton had been travelling south on Back Road when his 2003 Volvo went off the paved portion of the roadway and severed a utility pole, disrupting power to a significant portion of the City. Crews from Eversource responded and restored power after roughly seven hours.

Tilton was transported to the Wentworth-Douglass Hospital by Dover Fire & Rescue for the treatment of non-life threatening injuries. Upon being discharged from the hospital, Tilton was arrested for DWI, Subsequent Offense and has been released on \$2,500 personal recognizance bail pending a court date on March 27, 2017.
