Media Release **May 4, 2017**

The Dover Police Department and the Office of The Chief Medical Examiner are currently investigating an unattended death that occurred in Dover on Wednesday, May 3, 2017.

At approximately 9:08 PM on May 3rd, the Dover Police and Dover Fire and Rescue responded to the area of Merry and Ridge Streets in Dover for a report of an unconscious individual. Upon arrival, they located the body of an adult male, who was pronounced dead at the scene.

At this time the Dover Police Department is not identifying the individual, pending the notification of next of kin.

The Office of the Chief Medical Examiner will determine the cause and manner of the man's death. An autopsy will be conducted in the coming days.

This case is being investigated by the Dover Police Department's Special Investigations Bureau.
