## **PRESS RELEASE**

**December 12, 2017**

The Dover Police Department is requesting the public's assistance with an indecent exposure investigation.

The incident occurred at 5:07 PM on December 9, 2017, at Dunkin Donuts, 165 Portland Avenue. Dover Police responded after an employee reported that a male drive-thru customer purchased an item with his pants unzipped and his genitals exposed.

The employee described the suspect as a white male with "scruffy" facial hair. Further investigation revealed that the suspect was driving what is believed to be a gold Mercury Grand Marquis.

Detectives from the department's Special Investigations Bureau have obtained security footage from the business and hope for the public's assistance to identify the suspect. Attached with this release is an image of the suspect, and a photo of a Mercury Grand Marquis for example purposes (not the actual vehicle).
