## Press Release



**February 14, 2018**

Chief Anthony Colarusso of the Dover Police Department announces the arrest of Jarred Bartlett, 22 years old, of 48 Royal Crest Drive, Rochester, NH, on a charge of Reckless Conduct and Criminal Threatening.

On February 9th, Bartlett's girlfriend, a 23 year old woman who lives on Lakeview Drive, contacted the DPD to report Bartlett had given her a ride in his car to Lakeview Drive on the morning of February 6<sup>th</sup>. She reported the two argued, and, after she got out of the car at her residence, Bartlett fired a shot before driving away. It does not appear Bartlett fired the shot at her. No injuries or property damage occurred as a result of this incident.

Mr. Bartlett was subsequently arrested by the Rochester Police Department for the incidents that occurred in the City of Rochester with the same victim. After the Dover Police Department completed its investigation, Mr. Bartlett was arrested on February 13, 2018, at the Strafford County House of Correction where he was being held on the Rochester charges.

Mr. Bartlett was arraigned in Strafford County Superior Court on February 13, 2018, and was held on \$10,000.00 cash bail.
