Chief William Breault of the Dover Police Department announces the arrest of Charles Paul, 52 years old, of 6 Western Avenue #4, Dover, for failing to comply with sex offender registration laws.

Paul was convicted of two counts of Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault in Rockingham County Superior Court in 1987. As a result of his convictions, Paul is required to register as a sexual offender, which includes providing the address of his residence to the police department having jurisdiction where he is residing.

Dover Police Department detectives began an investigation on May 25, 2018, after receiving information that Paul was living at a residence he had not previously reported to the police department. As a result of the investigation, DPD detectives obtained an arrest warrant for Paul charging him with a Class B felony for failing to comply with RSA 651-B:4: "Duty to Report."

On June 11, 2018, officers located and arrested Paul on Washington Street. Paul was released \$1500.00 personal recognizance bail and is scheduled to be arraigned in the Strafford County Superior Court on June 28, 2018 at 12:30 PM.
