Chief William Breault of the Dover Police Department announces an arrest in the robbery at the Bank of New Hampshire at 845 Central Avenue in Dover that occurred at approximately 2:17 PM on Thursday, July 12, 2018.

A male suspect entered the bank and demanded cash. After obtaining a sum of cash, he fled the scene in a silver four door sedan.

No weapons were displayed and there were no injuries as a result of the robbery.

After surveillance images of the suspect were broadcast by various news media the Dover Police Department received a tip regarding the suspect's identity. After further investigation, detectives were able to identify James Aubin, 45, of 24 Jay Way, Rochester, NH, as the individual responsible. Dover police detectives arrested Aubin without incident at his residence at approximately 6:00 PM on July 12, 2018. Aubin has been charged with one count of robbery, a felony.

Aubin was held at the Strafford County House of Correction on \$10,000.00 cash bail. He will be arraigned in Strafford County Superior Court at 9:00 AM on Friday, July 13, 2018.
