DOVER POLICE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES ARREST IN BURGLARY INVESTIGATION

DOVER, NH, July 24, 2019 - Chief William Breault of the Dover Police Department announces that an arrest has been made as a result of a recent burglary at 251 Central Avenue, Dover.

In the incident, multiple business were entered and cash was stolen either on the night of July 15th or during the early morning hours of July 16th.

After analyzing evidence gathered by DPD Crime Scene Unit members and DPD patrol officers, DPD detectives obtained an arrest warrant for Stephen Hines, 52 years old, of Dover, NH, on a charge of Burglary

Hines was arrested on the warrant by officers of the Rochester Police Department on Wakefield Street in Rochester at approximately 10:45 AM on July 24, 2019. He refused the services of a bail commissioner and will be arraigned in Strafford County Superior Court on July 25, 2019 at 11:00 AM.
