DOVER POLICE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCE ARREST WARRANTS ISSUED FOR SEX OFFENDERS

DOVER, NH, August 22, 2019 - Chief William Breault of the Dover Police Department announces that arrest warrants have been issued as a result of two sex offenders failing to register as required by law.

Keith Pare is a registered Tier II sexual offender in the State of New Hampshire following a conviction for Felonious Sexual Assault out of the Strafford County Superior Court on January 13, 1996. As a result of his convictions, Pare is required to register as a sexual offender semi-annually, and he has failed to do so.

Mr. Pare is a 44 year-old white male approximately 5'11" tall and 150 lbs. He has tattoos on his arms and legs. Pare's whereabouts are currently unknown, as he currently has no fixed address, but is known to frequent downtown Dover. A photo of Pare will be attached to this release.

Andrew Sibik is a registered Tier III sexual offender in the State of New Hampshire following two convictions for Felonious Sexual Assault in the Strafford County Superior Court on February 27, 2014. As a result of his convictions, Sibik is required to register as a sexual offender quarterly, and he has failed to do so.

Mr. Sibik is a 27 year-old white male approximately 5'5" tall and 130 lbs. He has black hair and brown eyes. Sibik's whereabouts are currently unknown, as he currently has no fixed address, but is known to frequent downtown Dover. A photo of Sibik will be attached to this release.

DPD Special investigations Unit detectives have obtained felony arrest warrants for both men charging them with violating NHRSA 651-B:4 "Duty to Report". DPD officers are attempting to locate and arrest them at this time.
