



DOVER POLICE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES ARREST IN BURGLARY INVESTIGATION

DOVER, NH, December 4, 2019 - Chief William Breault of the Dover Police Department announces that an arrest has been made as a result of a recent residential burglary on Kent Avenue, Dover.

Residents of the home reported the burglary occurred during the day on December 3, 2019. The DPD Crime Scene Unit and Special Investigations Unit responded and were able to quickly identify a suspect, Justin Collier, 28, of Somersworth. Collier had been arrested earlier on December 3rd by the Somersworth Police Department. Evidence gathered by SPD officers linked Collier to the burglary in Dover.

DPD detectives arrested Collier for burglary, a felony, at the Strafford County House of Correction where he was being held as a result of the Somersworth arrest. He refused the services of a bail commissioner and will be arraigned in Strafford County Superior Court on December 4, 2019 at 11:00 AM.
