DOVER, NH, November 23, 2020 - Chief William Breault of the Dover Police Department announces the arrest of Joshua A. Gosselin, age 38, with no fixed address, on the charge of burglary

On November 22, 2020 at approximately 12:45 PM, Dover Police responded to a residence on River Street for burglary report. The homeowner returned after having been out for several hours and noted broken glass by the front door and lights on inside the residence. Responding officers searched the house and located Joshua Gosselin in the basement. Gosselin was taken into custody and found in possession of some of the resident's jewelry during a search incident to arrest.

Gosselin was subsequently charged with Burglary, a felony and held in preventive detention pending arraignment at the Strafford County Superior Court on November 23, 2020.
