### **DOVER POLICE INVESTIGATION AND TACTICAL TEAM ACTIVATION**

**Dover, NH**, June 23, 2024 – On June 22, 2024, at approximately 9:15 P.M., Dover police officers responded to 24 Littleworth Road for a reported domestic disturbance involving a firearm. On scene, officers were able to remove two adults from the home, while the suspect, 44-year-old George Sousane, refused to cooperate.

The Strafford County Regional Tactical Operations Unit was activated and was ultimately able to negotiate Sousane to surrender. Sousane was charged with Resisting Arrest, a misdemeanor, and Criminal Threatening with a Deadly Weapon, a felony. He was held without bail and will remain in custody at the Strafford County Jail. He is scheduled to be arraigned at the 7<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court in Dover on June 24, 2024 at 8:30 A.M.

After Sousane was in custody, a search warrant was obtained by Dover Police detectives to recover evidence related to the investigation, which included multiple firearms.
