DOVER POLICE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES RECKLESS CONDUCT ARREST

DOVER, NH, September 30, 2025 – Chief David Terlemezian of the Dover Police Department announces that an arrest has been made following a motor vehicle disturbance investigation.

On the afternoon of September 29, 2025, Richard Hebbard, 66, of Dover, New Hampshire, surrendered to the Dover Police after detectives obtained an arrest warrant charging him with Reckless Conduct, a felony offense.

The arrest stems from an investigation that began after Dover Police responded to a motor vehicle disturbance on Spruce Lane. The victim of this incident – an adult male, alleged that while running on Spruce Lane, he was almost struck by Hebbard, who recklessly drove at him, forcing him off the roadway.

Hebbard is being held in preventative detention at the Strafford County House of Corrections. He is scheduled to be arraigned on Tuesday, September 30, 2025, at 10:00 A.M. in the 7th Circuit Court – District Division – Dover.
