RULES RELATED TO COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

DO NOT ENTER IF YOU:

- 1 Are exhibiting ANY symptoms of the coronavirus: mild to severe respiratory illness with fever, cough and difficulty breathing or other symptoms identified by the CDC**
- 2 Have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days**
- 3 Are a vulnerable individual (or lives or cares for a vulnerable individual) with serious underlying health conditions, including high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, obesity, asthma, or whose immune system is compromised such as by chemotherapy for cancer or other conditions requiring such therapy.**

BEFORE ENTERING:

- 1. Wash your hands with soap and water and bring personal use hand sanitizer with you**
- 2. Clean and wipe down the dogs leash**
- 3. Do not bring in dog toys**
- 4. Bring a personal use water bottle**
- 5. Consider wearing a face covering, gloves**
- 6. If you need to sneeze or cough, do so into a tissue or upper sleeve**
- 7. Do not congregate in the parking lot and use social distancing of a minimum of 6 feet between dog owners.**

WHILE IN THE DOG PARK:

- 1. Limit of 10 people inside the fenced in area at any one time and maintain a 6 foot social distance throughout your stay**
- 2. Use the Dog Park in concert with others and be aware of others who may be waiting to enter if there are 10 people inside.**
- 3. Only in an emergency should dog owners be in close proximity to other people.**
- 4. Do not touch any other's dogs or leashes.**

AFTERWARD:

- 1. Leave the park as soon as possible**
- 2. Wash your hands thoroughly or use hand sanitizer after leaving the area.**
- 3. Thoroughly wash any equipment brought to the park**

FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN LOSS OF PRIVILEGES OR CLOSURE OF THE DOG PARK
