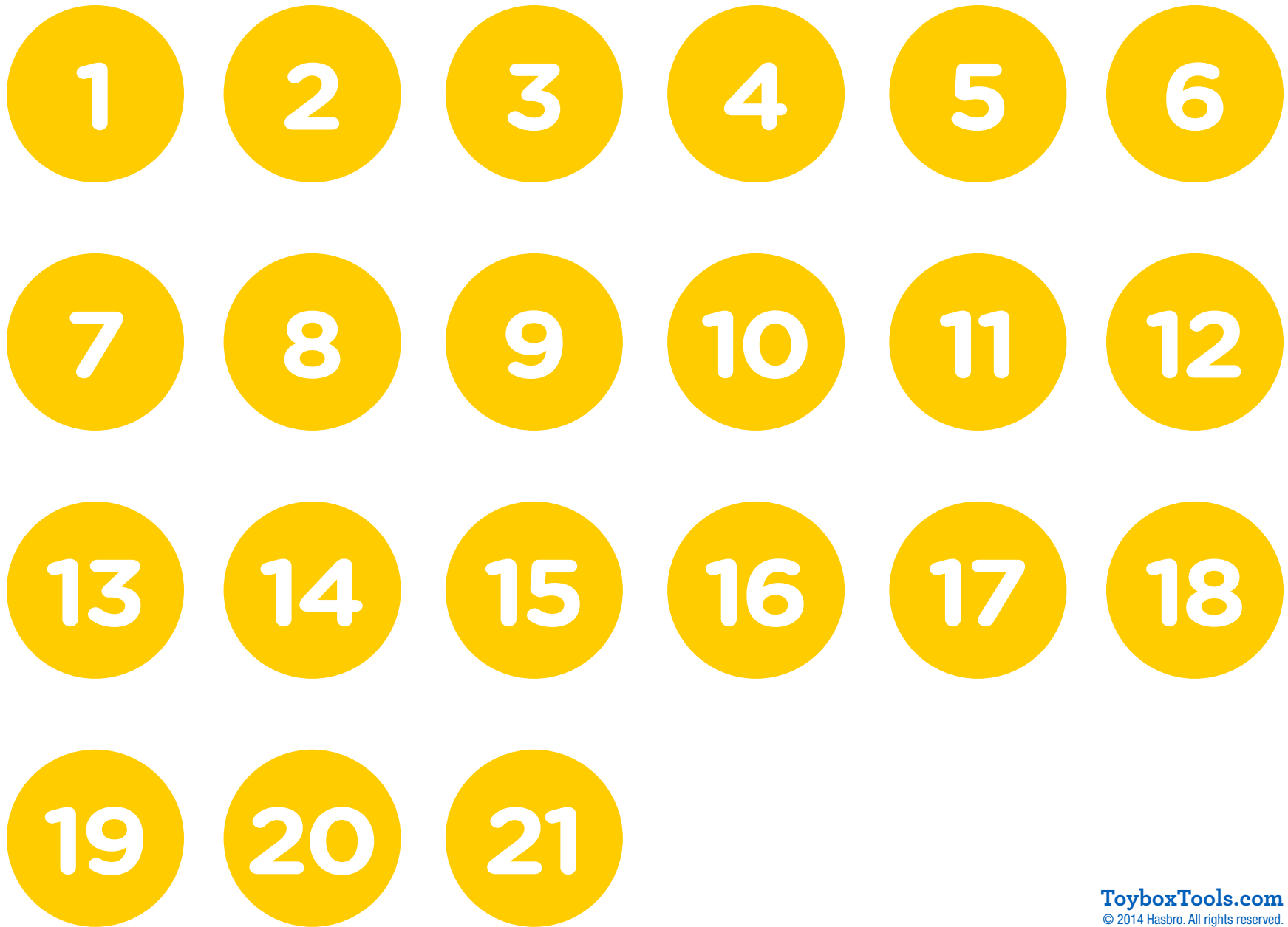

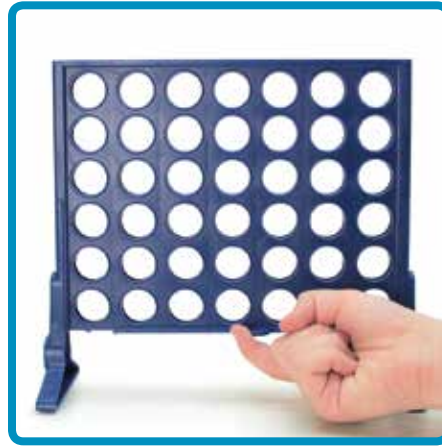

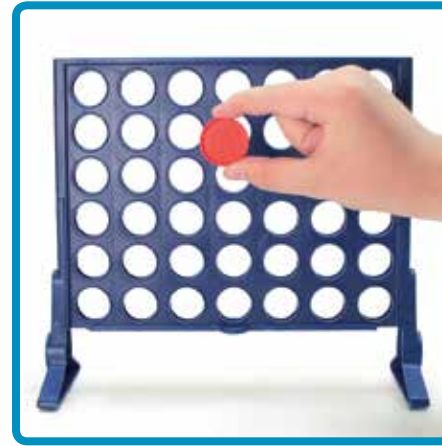
The CONNECT 4 game comes with:



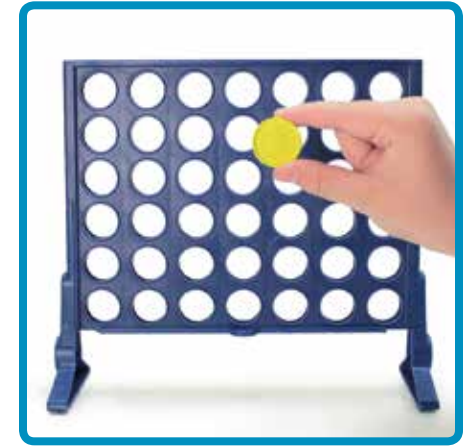
A grid to put

Yellow discs

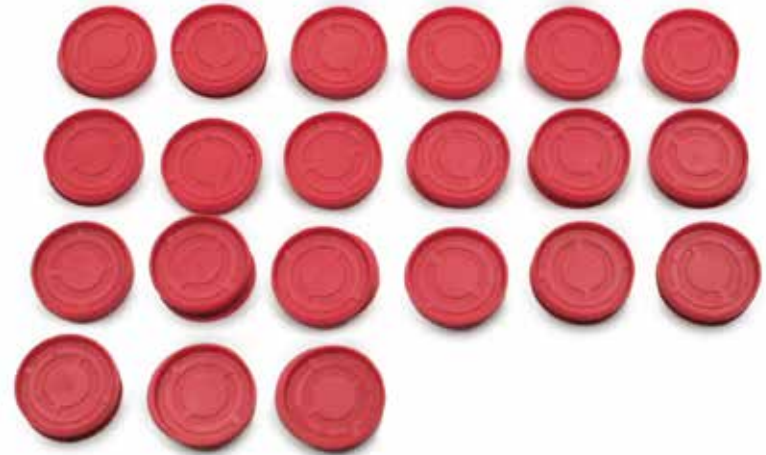
Here is a red disc board to count the discs.

13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21



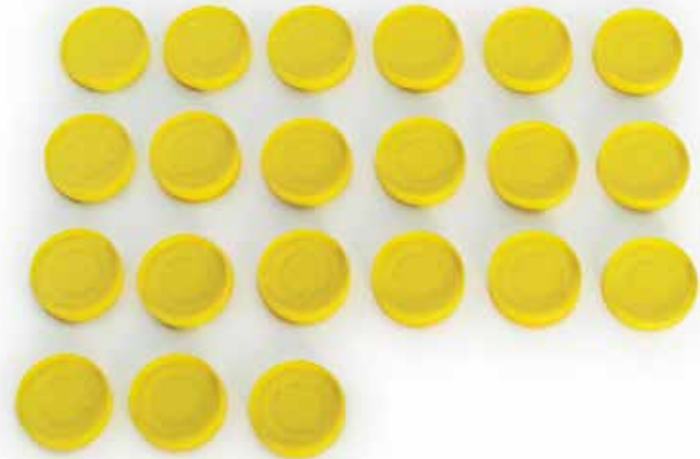
Here is a yellow disc board to count the yellow discs.

Match the discs to the circles.



Count:

1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12,
13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21



You can put the discs in the grid.



**Place the disc on top
of an open slot.**



**Drop the disc and
watch it fall to the
bottom.**



**Drop another disc
and watch it fall to
the bottom.**

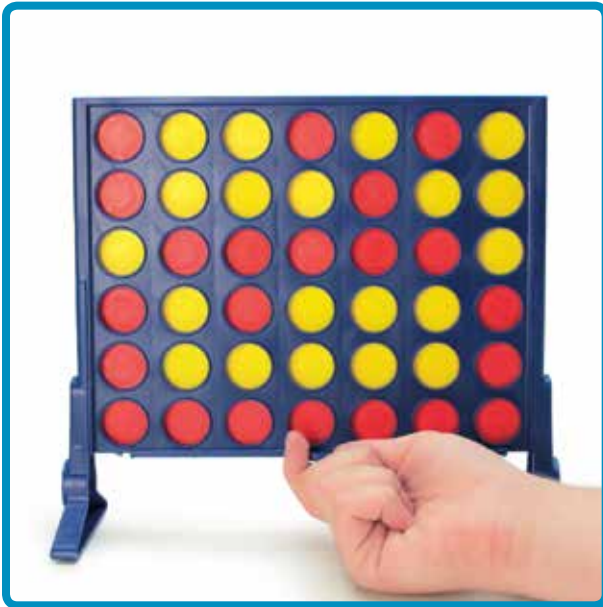


You can fill the grid with discs.



The grid is full—no more open circles.

It's time to let the discs fall out.



**Put your finger on the slider
and push to the left.**

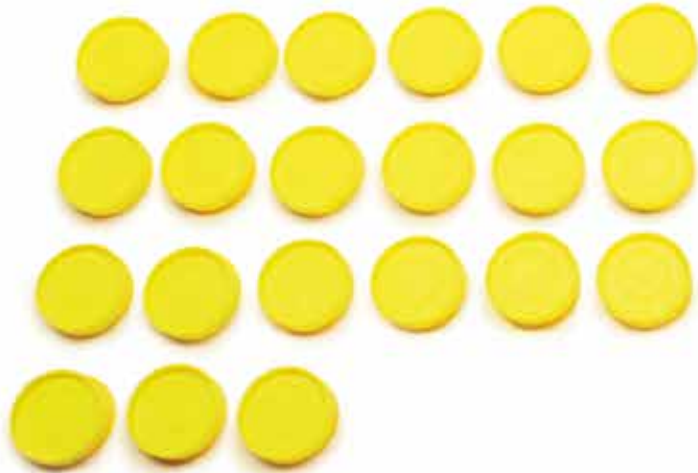


**You can watch the discs
