

At Home Creation Station

Cardboard Tube Binoculars



Supplies needed:

two cardboard paper rolls

yarn, string, or ribbon

glue/ scissors/ hole punch

paint, markers, decorative tape, construction paper, or stickers for decoration

Directions:

1. Use two cardboard tubes that are the same size (toilet paper rolls work the best). Decorate the two tubes any way you'd like with paint, markers, washi tape, construction paper, stickers, etc.

2. Glue the two tubes together to create either side of the binoculars, or wind tape around the two tubes to hold them together.

3. Punch holes in the end of each tube. Cut an arm's length of yarn or string and tie one end through each of the holes to create a loop to hold the binoculars around your neck. Then go outside and see if you can spot some birds with your binoculars. Have fun!
