At Home Creation Station Tissue Box Guitar



You will need:

empty tissue box (the long kind)
empty paper towel tube
3 or 4 rubber bands
any kind of tape
scissors
marker or pen

Directions:

- 1. Cut around the edge of the opening to get out the plastic that the tissues come through. This will make it easier to strum.
- 2. Now you're going to be making a hole in the box for the neck/paper towel roll. Go to one of the small sides of the box, and put your paper towel roll on top. Use your marker to trace around the roll, and then cut out the circle.
- 3. Next, insert the paper towel tube into the hole about 2 inches. If there is much space around the tube, and it doesn't stay well, stick tape around it to help stop it from sliding.
- 4. Now you can add the strings by putting rubber bands around the box, one or two on each side of the tube. Try using rubber bands that are different thicknesses so that each string makes a different sound. Decorate your guitar if you wish. Have fun and strum on!
