

# At Home Creation Station – SRP 2020 – Week 5

## Mouse Finger Puppets



### **At home supplies needed:**

sheet of white paper  
scissors/ glue  
markers/ pencil  
plate for tracing (approx. 6 - 7 inch diameter)

### **Directions:**

1. Trace and cut a circle approximately 6 - 7 inches in diameter. Fold the circle in half and half again – so you have folded lines that divide the circle into quarters. Cut out the quarters – each one will make one mouse.
2. Spread glue on one long edge of each quarter circle, roll up in a cone shape and secure.
3. For each mouse, cut two tear drops for ears, one long thin piece of paper for the tail (curl with scissors) and two shorter thin strips of paper for whiskers. Glue the tail to the bottom inside of the cone.
4. Color in the tear drop ears for the mouse, add glue to the bottom and glue each ear half way along the cone. Cross the two short strips of paper, add glue and secure underneath the top of the cone. Add two small black eyes and a little nose. Your paper cone mice finger puppets are finished! Have fun!
