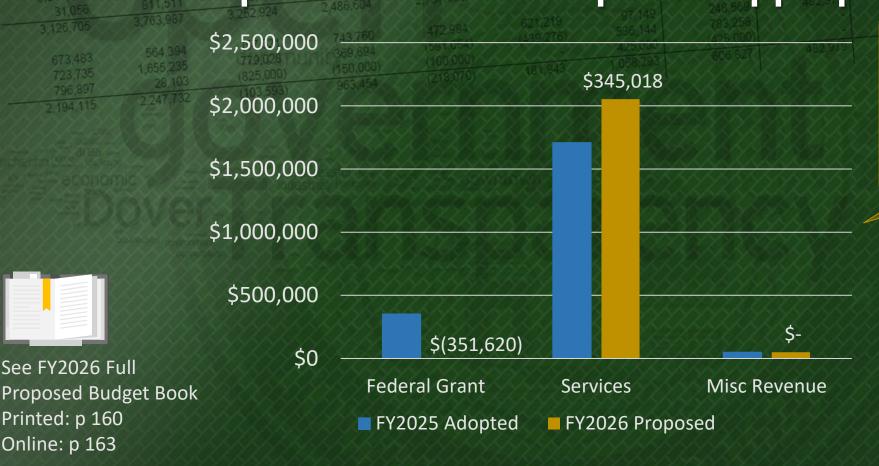


WHO WE ARE

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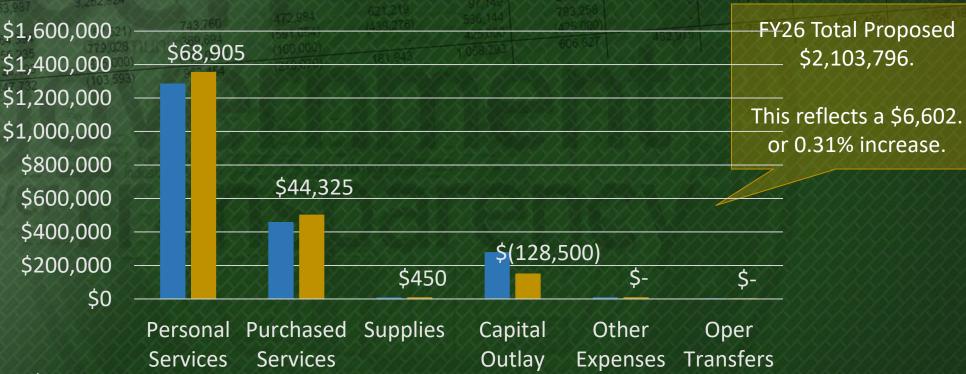
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FY26 Total Proposed \$2,103,796.

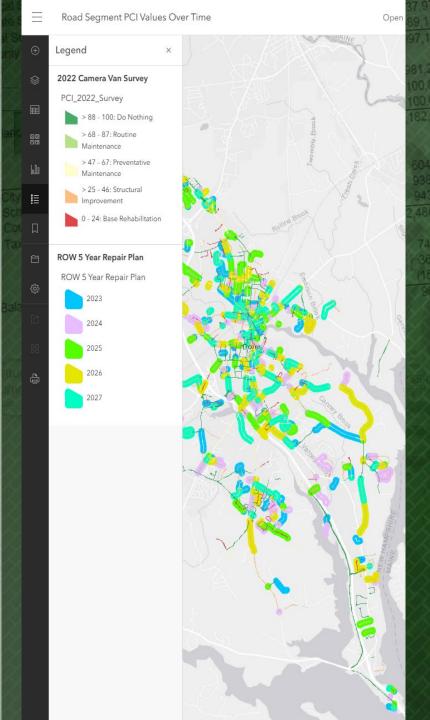
