QUALIFICATIONS: Dover City Charter, Section C2-2. Ward Officers. At each municipal election, the inhabitants of each ward shall choose three Selectpersons, a Clerk and Moderator and a Supervisor of the Checklist, who, being duly sworn, shall perform and discharge respectfully the duties of said officers for said wards and shall hold office until their successors are duly elected and qualified. In case of any vacancy in said offices, in any ward, the City Council shall fill such vacancy at its first regular meeting after such vacancy shall occur. Appointees shall be from the same ward in which the vacancy exists and shall hold office for the unexpired term.
